The Cube serves coffee direct from rookie coffee farmer Álvaro Soberanes in Veracruz, Mexico, cultivated at 1500m under leguminous trees that pump nitrogen back into the soil – nothing more needs to be added. Roasted to order in Littlehampton UK, this coffee is as single estate as the Microplex itself. Our watching-with-baby screenings are for parents/carers with young babies (up to one year) to enjoy a movie in the company of other parents and their offspring. The Cube provides an area for prams, baby changing facilities, lowered movie volume and extra lighting in the auditorium. There will always be a friendly Front of House on hand to help. 
