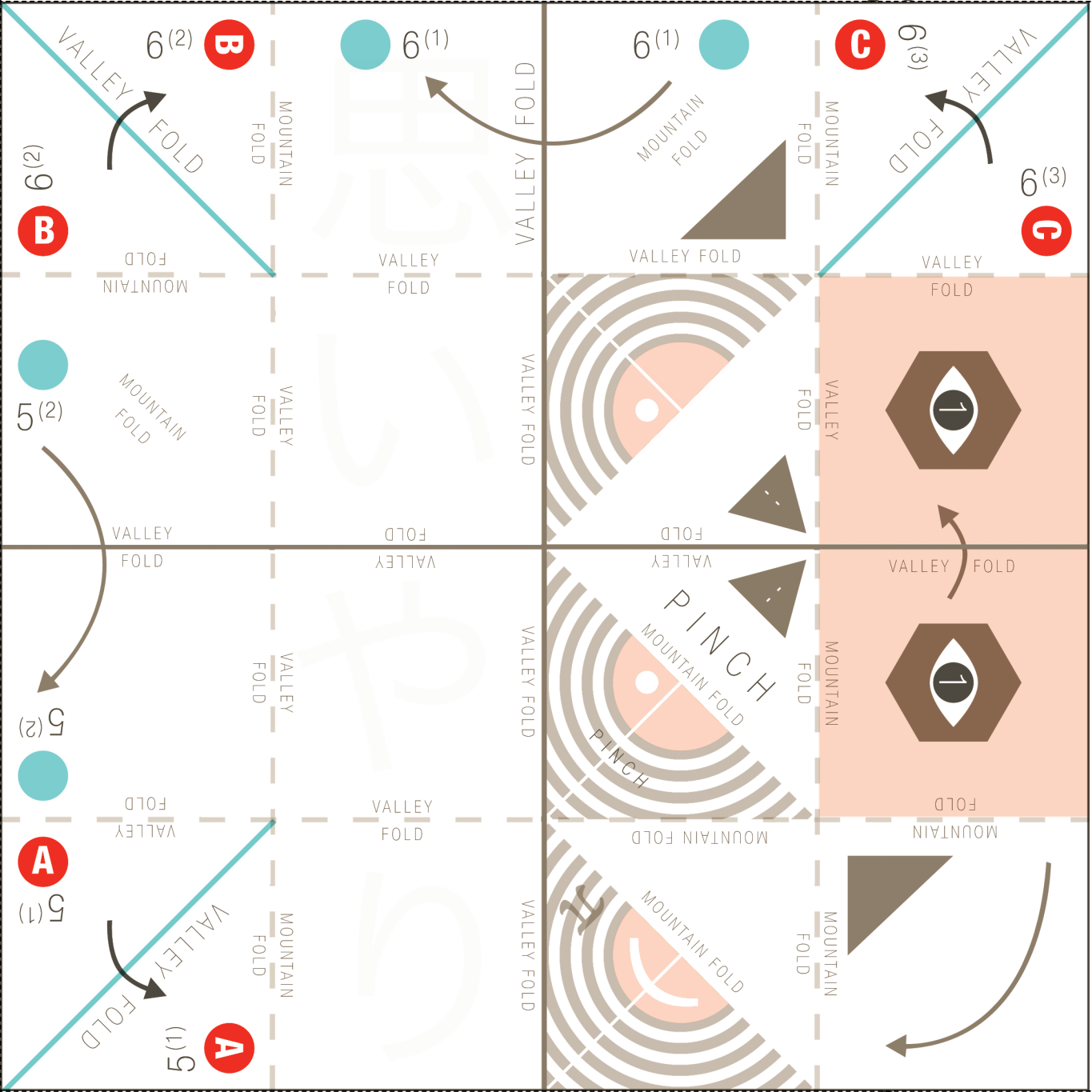

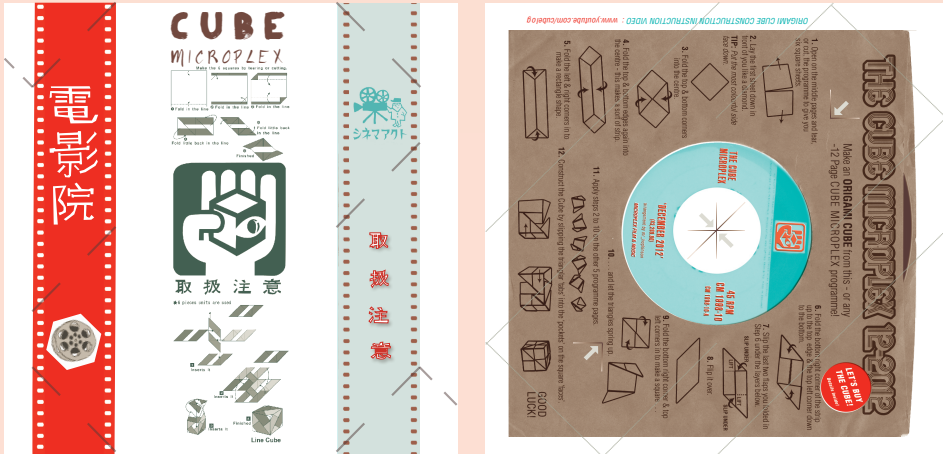
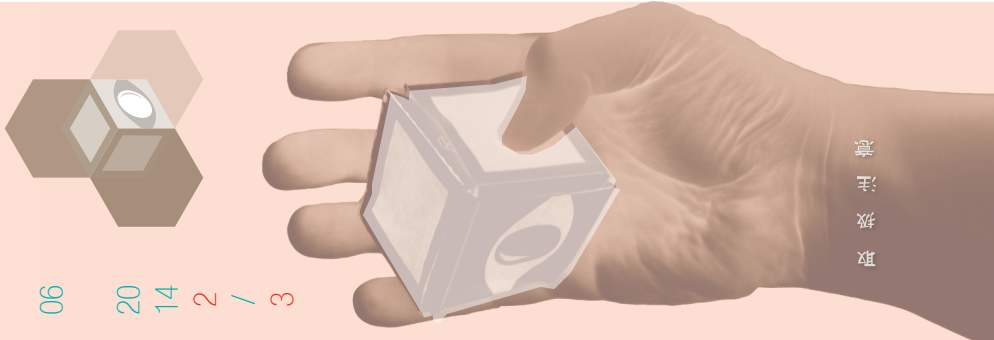

A Decade of Punk in Washington, DC (1980-90)

Salad Days rides the decade when seminal bands like *Bad Brains*, *Minor Threat*, *Government Issue*, *Scream*, *Void*, *Faith*, *Rites of Spring*, *Marginal Man*, *Fugazi*, and others released their own records & booked their own shows—without major record label constraints or mainstream media scrutiny.

At age sixteen *Browning* left home to join a travelling circus &, drawing on his real life experiences, created *Freaks*. Given carte blanche by the studio off the back of his success a year earlier with *Dracula* (1931), and, operating in a pre-code era, *Browning* was able to celebrate circus life & still show everything honestly - free from censorship or taboo.

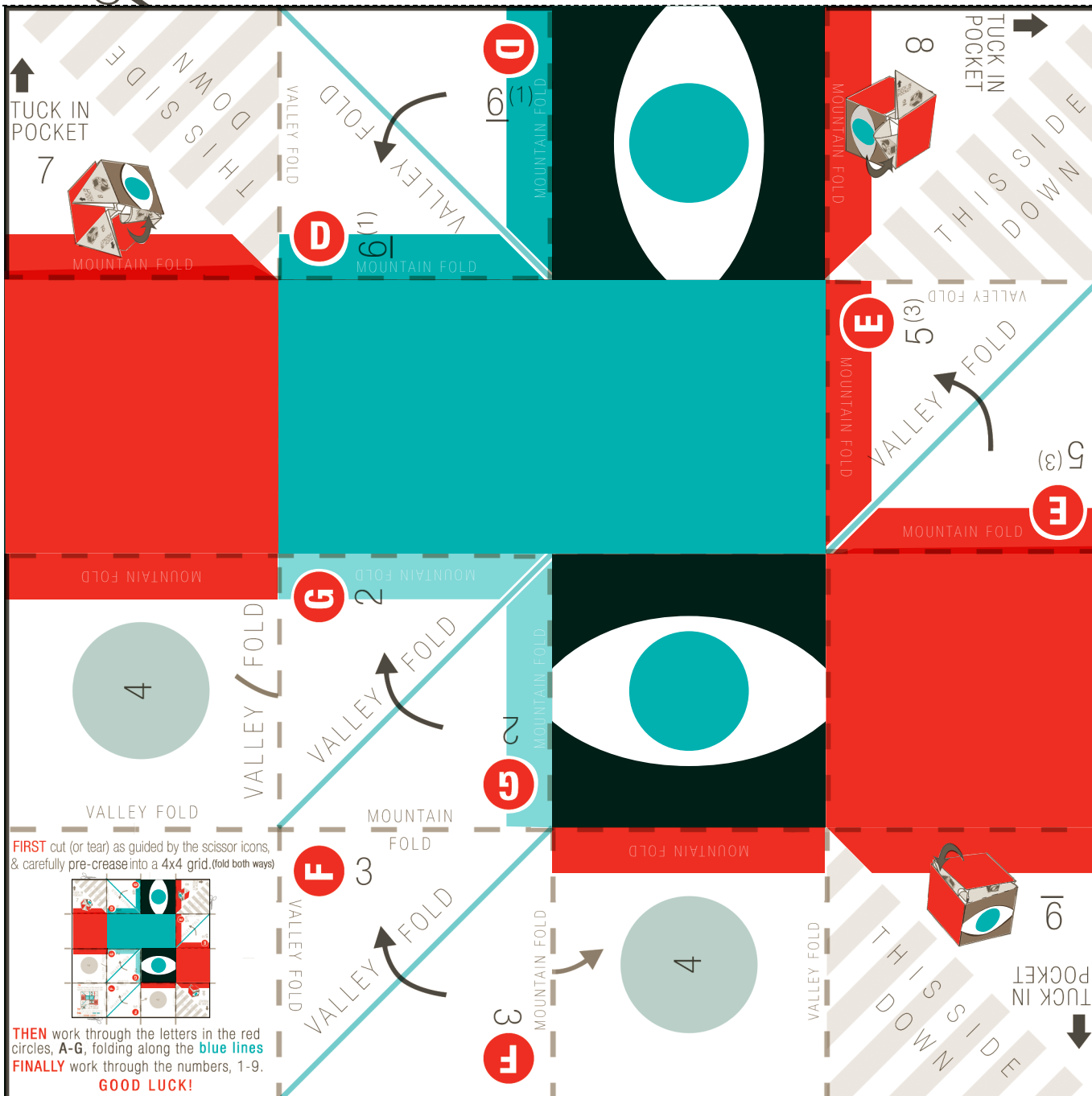
This adventure - comedy - documentary uncovers the hidden truths of one of the most destructive industries impacting the planet today - the practices of the animal agriculture industry.
