

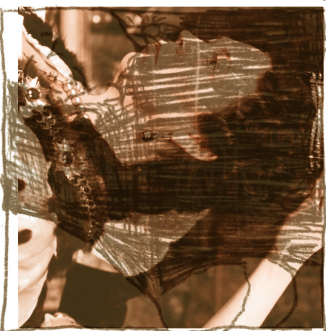
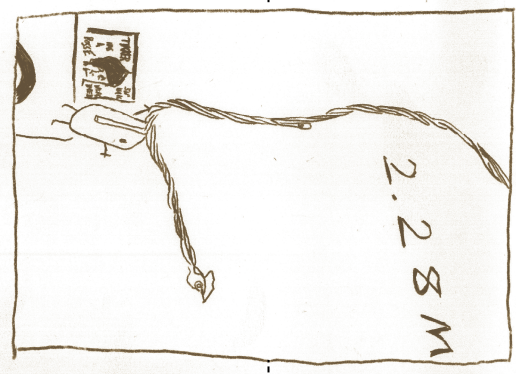

ALEXANDER TUCKER, RAINBOW VAMN, SHIVER

There is a distinct otherworldiness to Alexander Tucker's art. Psychedelic without ever resorting to tropes of the genre, it's the subtle thread connecting every aspect of his output, from the vibrant and hypnotic avant-pop of Grumbling Fur, his duo with Daniel O'Sullivan, to extended drone collaborations with Charlemagne Palestine and Stephen O'Malley, to his beautiful yet strangely unnerving paintings and comics.
